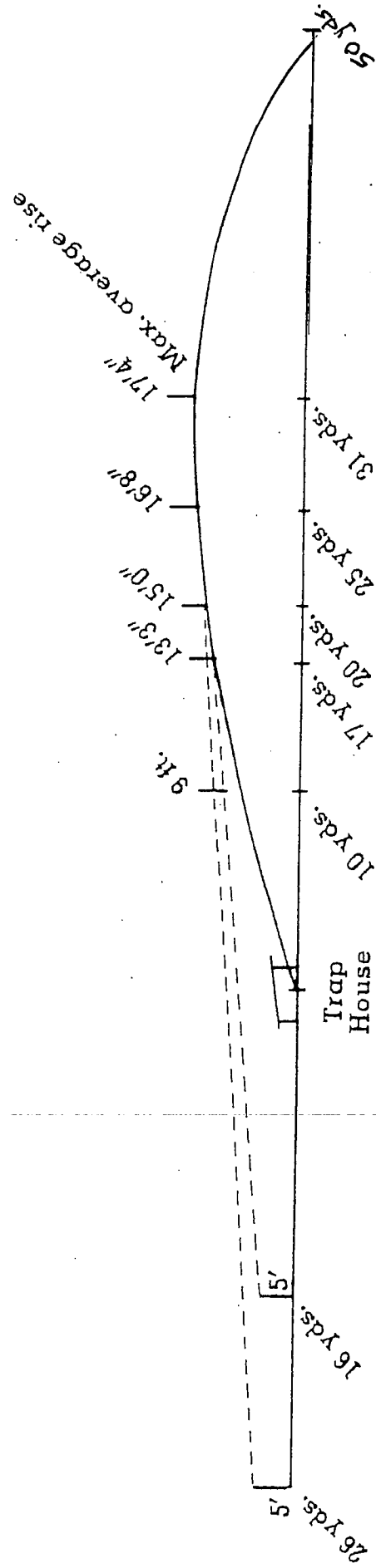


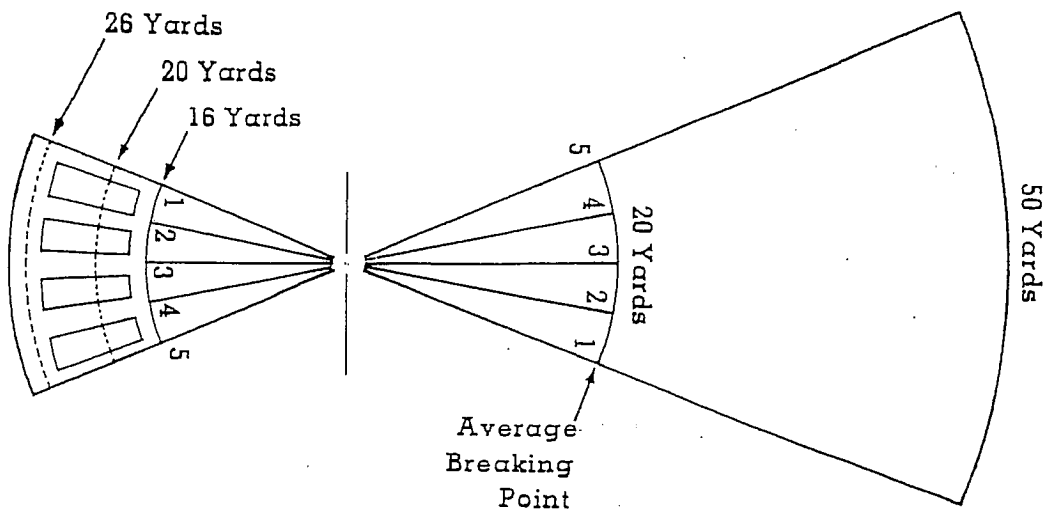
ARC OF TARGET FLIGHT SHOWING ELEVATIONS



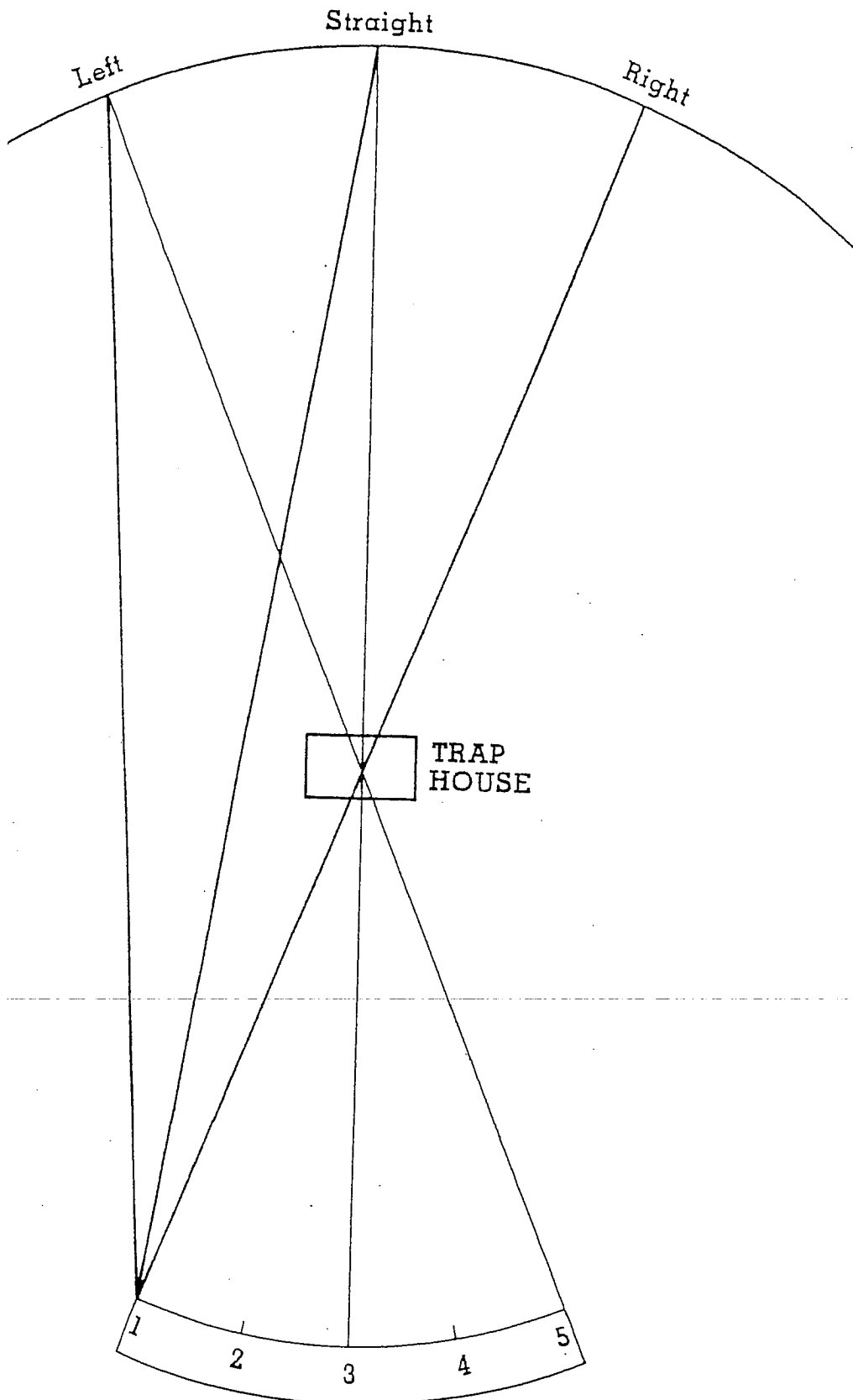
The normal arc of a trap target's flight. In singles, targets are broken about 20 yards from the traphouse, or about 36 yards from the shooter.

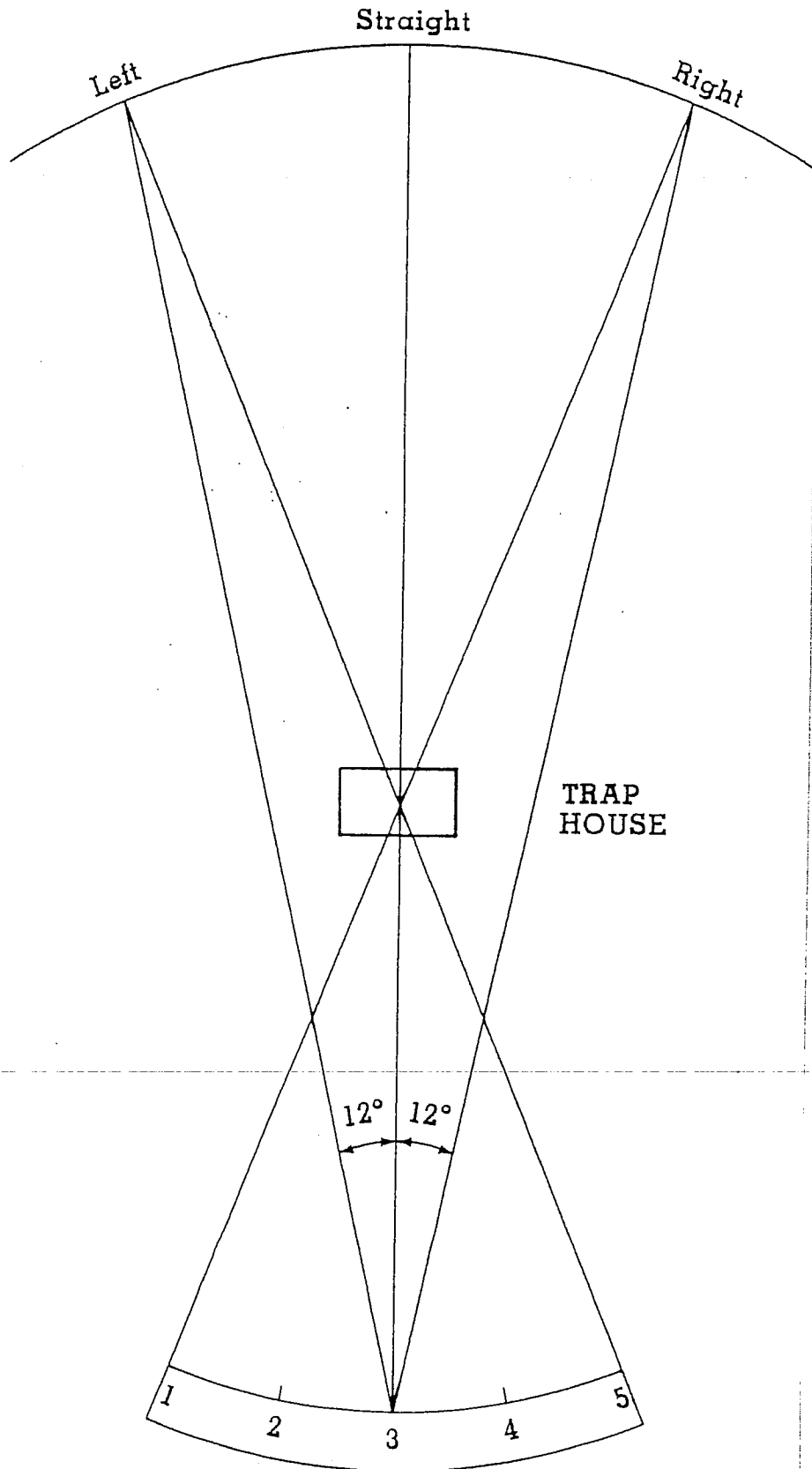
