

1. Presentation (at least five minutes, everyone participates, file e-mailed to [smythe@apsu.edu](mailto:smythe@apsu.edu) before class)
- \_\_\_\_\_(15) Does the presentation appear to be *prepared, interesting*, and *well-organized*?
  - \_\_\_\_\_(5) Is the visual aid supporting the presentation, easy to view, and professional?
  - \_\_\_\_\_(5) Does the presentation relate to class concepts and cover the topic thoroughly?

2. Paper (3 to 5 pages, given to me by the start of class)
- \_\_\_\_\_(3) Cover page (**title, plagiarism statement, group member names and signatures**)

Individual totals will be multiplied by a factor (between 0 and 1.2) that represents how much you participated in this group project. I will determine this factor using

1. your group peer evaluations of each other and
2. how much I see you participating during the presentation, our group conference, and the list of group meetings.

**Each person needs to e-mail me peer evaluations for your group by midnight on the date of your group presentation.** List each group member's and corresponding rank from 0 (never did a single thing for the entire project) to 12 (participated above and beyond expectations) reflecting how much each group member participated (not including you). A score of 10 should be given if the group member participated as expected. A score of 5 should be given if the group member participated half as much as expected.

**Papers containing any text outside of quotation marks that has been taken directly from any source other than your group members will result in every single group member failing the entire course.**
